Connecting BYOD devices to FUSD-Students wifi

- Students need to "forget" all other FUSD networks on their device (FUSD-Guest, FUSD). Not "forgetting" all other FUSD networks will cause issues when trying to make the new connection.
- Students need to log in using their <u>4digit@fresnou.org</u> login. Using @edisoncomputech.com will not grant access to the FUSD-Students network.
- Students that cannot connect to internet outside FUSD will not be able to connect within FUSD. This indicates an issue with the device or the device's software.
